Dear Valued Customer:

The undersigned, Huhtamaki Foodservice, Inc., ("SELLER"), with principal offices at DeSoto, Kansas, hereby guarantees for purposes of Section 303(c)(2) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, that Chinnet brand plates, item numbers 21217, 21225 and 21227, supplied to Saalfeld ("BUYER") by SELLER, as of the date of such shipment or delivery, to be, on such date, not adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, and not an article which may not, under the provisions of Section 404 and 409 of the Act, be introduced into interstate commerce.

The SELLER further guarantees that the above product is made from components, raw materials and manufacturing adjuvants that, based on SELLER's verification of its materials and assurances from SELLER's suppliers for purchased materials, comply with the applicable federal food additive regulations governing food contact materials. Specifically, Seller guarantees that Chinnet plates item numbers 21217, 21225 and 21227, when shipped, complies with the following section of Title 21 of the Code of Federal Regulations issued under the authority of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act as amended:

176.170: Components of paper and paperboard in contact with aqueous and fatty foods.

When shipped, the aforementioned product is suitable for packaging the following types of foods: Types II, III, VII-A and VII-B as described in 21 C.F.R. 176.170 Table 1, when packaged and stored under temperature conditions equivalent to FDA's Condition of Use B, as described in 21 C.F.R. 176.170 Table 2. (The identity of FDA's food types and temperature conditions are set forth as Annex I and Annex II, respectively, to this letter.)

All references to the above food and drug regulation(s) and their application to the above-named product are based on SELLER's interpretation of the Code of Federal Regulations Section 21, Part 170 to 190, revised April 1, 2004. Our statement that the above product(s) can be used in compliance with the above FDA regulation(s) is predicated on the assumption that the product will not be altered by the addition of other unregulated substances.

This guaranty, which is consistent with FDA's guidelines provided in 21 C.F.R. § 7.13, and offered in keeping with applicable USDA requirements as set forth in 9 C.F.R. §§ 317.24(b) and 381.44(b), is non-assignable and shall continue in effect for five (5) years from the date hereon, unless terminated sooner
